

WEST VIRGINIA WILD & WONDERFUL CELTIC FESTIVAL & HIGHLAND GAMES CHARLES ED LOGAN, SR., CLAN CONVENER

Clan Logan was the Honor Clan for the 2025 edition of the West Virginia Wild and Wonderful Celtic Festival and Highland Games. This honor was voted upon by the clans attending the 2024 games, and we were really surprised when they made the announcement at the end of the games last year. It meant we were definitely coming back for 2025. The organization provided the two tents, tables, and chairs, all for free, which meant I did not have to pack them in the SUV and set up and tear down.

Because of being the Honor Clan, we needed to try and get more Logans to the games for better representation as we led the clan parade. So, we put the word out and invited people. Clan Logan Society International President, Kevin Logan, and his wife, Lisa, joined us, along with past Treasurer and longtime clan tent host at Grandfather Mountain, Randy Horne, and his wife, Katie. Bill Logan, who lives a half mile from the venue, also came and invited many other Logans from the Limb 1 group who are in Pennsylvania. A total of 15 Logans walked in the parade, second in size only to the parade in Estes Park, Colorado. It was a great turn-out.

WEST VIRGINIA WILD & WONDERFUL CELTIC FESTIVAL & HIGHLAND GAMES

The weather was a little on the hot side, but the rain had finally stopped, and according to Bill Logan, the day was probably reserved for getting caught up on the grass cutting. This was the reason he thought the crowd was so small. The year before, there were over 3,000 in attendance. This year, probably not even half that number, but we had a great turnout for Logans. Not even all of the Logans there marched with us; some took photos of the rest of us marching.

The event had all the makings of a wonderful Highland Games. The men and women athletes performing right in front of us, as the clan row is on three sides of the athletic field. The women perform the exact same events as the men. Then the Highland dancing, the 5K run, hairy coos, border collies, and Irish wolfhounds. Not to mention live music from pipe and drums bands and Celtic bands. As with any Highland games, the merchandise and food vendors were also there.

There were 27 clan tents this year and 31 clans in the clan parade.

This was the first year this event has been called the Georgia Mountain Scottish Festival and Highland Games. It was previously known as the Blairsville Scottish Games and Festival. They moved into a new venue, and it's absolutely fabulous. They really put their best effort into these games, with more clans – 42 separate clans there – more vendors, demonstrators, pipe and drum bands, just about everything. And they pulled it off with clockwork precision. Even at the end of the games, they opened the gates for vehicles to load up. I was about 12th in line, and I was in, loaded, and out, on my way home in 14 minutes.

We didn't know what to expect, since it was Clan Logan's first adventure into these particular games. I had chosen it because a cousin lives near there, and I was hoping he could get away from his business for a few hours and come visit. While that did not happen, we were joined by Randy Horne and his wife Katie, with whom we've shared tent duties with every year since 2010 at Grandfather Mountain Scottish Games. To my surprise, coming down the road toward the clan tent, was fellow Clan Logan member Kathie Snyder and her husband, who is president of the Clan Sutherland Society. Kathie and her husband also attended the Clan Logan family convention in Edinburgh in April. She even marched with us in the clan parade.

Since it was our first time, I rented one of their spaces, a 9' X 15' enclosed area with electricity. I was happy I could leave my two clan tents at home for this trip but still brought my clan banner and flags. Turned out, I could not use them, since the road outside the enclosed area is asphalt, leaving me no way to stick them in the ground. The main issue we had while setting up was that the stall was like an oven, and my shirt quickly changed from dry to soaked in sweat. Kathleen had to go back out and find the Dollar General store to buy two fans to cool the place down. The fans were lifesavers. Then I visited my neighbors looking for a step stool and a staple gun, so we could decorate the inside. As usual, the clans helped out. They had just what I needed and were glad to let us borrow the stuff. It all worked out pretty nicely. You really do meet the nicest people at Scottish games events.

Once we got the clan display up and organized, we could take our walk about and see what the games had to offer and where everything was. I was rather surprised that directly across the road from the clan booths were the vendor booths, and they had a whole lot of vendors, which I gladly visited to get scones with strawberries and whipped cream on Sunday. I missed out on Saturday, by far the busier day, since they ran out rather early. They had a wide variety of vendors for everyone's shopping pleasures.

It was the demonstrators which really impressed me. They brought in the Appalachian Archers, Ax Daddy (ax throwing), Burnt Whisker Forge, Celtic Canines (Scottish dog breeds), Clan Nan Con (reenactors), Georgia Falconry Association, Highlander Fiber Friends (spinners and weavers), Highland Ponies, Lakin Farms (Scottish livestock), Red Creek Farm (sheepherders), and the Blacksmith Experience. It was a joy to stop by and see what the demonstrators were doing and learn more about their trades.



Now with all this going on, the crowds showed up to take it all in. Even though this was the first time for a Clan Logan tent at these games 12 or 13 different Logans and three Loggans stopped by. If they were a Logan, or had Logan in their name, I gave them a Clan Logan ink pen, which says Clan Logan Society International and has the Society's webpage address on it. That way, they can find us easily. Some even said they were Logans but their spelling is not on our list of other spellings, like Logine. Most did not just spell it Logan, like mine is, but one of the variations. But it was a great event and more Logans got to see our tent and know we are an active clan.

All in all, this was a very successful event, and I plan on returning to these games next year.

SCOTTISH RECIPES

CHERRY CAKE

Tricia Logan-Locke, Original Recipe by Marjorie Logan

A family favourite that my mum always baked at Christmastime. In Scotland, you can find glace cherries year-round but in California, the grocery shops only carry them around the holiday season. If you bake the cake, please share a photo.

INGREDIENTS

8 oz. glace cherries, halved
12 oz. self-rising flour (plus 1T for dusting cherries)
9 oz. unsalted softened butter
9.5 oz. caster sugar (baking sugar)
3 large eggs, beaten
1 T. lemon juice

- Preheat oven to 375.
- Grease and line a 9-inch cake tin (square or circle).
- Prepare cherries and toss in 1T of flour. Set aside.
- Cream butter and sugar in a large bowl until light and fluffy.
- Stir in lemon juice and beaten egg yolks.
- Sift flour into bowl and fold into mixture.
- Fold in cherries.
- Pour batter into cake tin and level the surface.
- Bake 375 for 90 minutes.
- After one hour, check cake for firmness and colour.
- If cake is not ready in the centre, continue cooking, checking every 10-15 minutes.



SCOTTISH RECIPES

You can add an optional glace to the top of the cake after it has cooled. Prick the top of the cake with a toothpick or knitting needle and drizzle the glace. Glace: In a heavy-based saucepan add 3.5 oz. of caster sugar and 3.5 fl. oz. water. Bring to a boil, add juice from 2 lemons and 1tspn. almond essence and boil rapidly for 5 minutes until syrupy. Leave to cool. Spoon over cake.

A few additional notes:

Remove as much of the sticky stuff from the cherries (either wipe or wash, rinse and dry well). Cherries like to sink to the bottom of the cake. You can leave a few to poke on top after batter is in the tin.

Depending on your oven, the top of the cake can get very brown along the sides before it is ready in the centre. Adding a paper lining to the outside of the tin making it higher than the sides may help stop the burning.

If you are new to baking, please remember that ounces for dry ingredients versus fluid ounces are different. The use of a digital scale that converts grams, ounces, and fluids is helpful. I made this cherry cake when I was new to baking not realizing the difference. I converted all the ounces to cups thinking it was the same thing. Well let's say it was not so great in the end.

Cake with glace will keep for 5 days in an airtight container. Cake without glace will keep longer.
